



THE FREE FRIDAY PATTERN

Yarn: Amore WS 160 by Borgo de' Pazzi Firenze

"Rampicante"

by Annarita Ceretti



"Rampicante" are fingerless mittens worked seamless in the round with cables on the back of the hand.

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SIZES: S / M (M / L) - **DIMENSIONS:** 17.5 / 19.5 (19.5 / 21.5) cm

MATERIALS:

- YARN: AMORE WS super soft Cashmere 160 by Borgo de' Pazzi Firenze (45% wool, 25% viscose, 20% polyamide, 10% cashmere (160 meters / 50 grams)

-Circular needle 40" (100 cm) for magic loop or double pointed needles - US 4 (3.5 mm) and US 5 (3.75 mm) (or as required to meet gauge)

Notions : 3 markers, waste yarn, cable needle, darning needle

GAUGE:

23 sts x 37 rows = 4" (10 cm)

ABBREVIATIONS

CO: cast on

r: round

k: knit

p: purl

M1R: pick up the horizontal bar between the sts from back to front, knit through front leg

M1L: pick up the horizontal bar between the sts from front to back, knit through back leg

M: marker (PM : place marker - SM : slip marker)

BOR: beginning of the round

c4b: slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold at back of work, knit 2 sts, knit 2 sts from cable needle

c4f: slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, knit 2 sts, knit 2 sts from cable needle

st (sts): stitch (stitches)

***...*:** repeat from * to *

BO: bind off



INSTRUCTIONS

Cuff (make two)

With smaller needles and German twisted cast on method CO 38 (42) sts. Place M for BOR and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist your sts.

r 1: * k1, p1 * around

r 2 – 20: repeat **r 1** 19 times more.

Switch to bigger needles and restart the count.

Right hand

r 1 – 4: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, k14

r 5: k7 (11), p1, c4f, k11, p1, k4

r 6 (begin thumb gusset) : k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, PM, k6, PM, k8

r 7: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, SM, M1R, k6, M1L, SM, k8

r 8: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, SM, k8, SM, k8

r 9: k7 (11), p1, k2, c4b, k9, p1, SM, M1R, k8, M1L, SM, k8

r 10 – 11 – 12: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, SM, k10, SM, k8

r 13: k7 (11), p1, c4f, c4f, k7, p1, SM, M1R, k10, M1L, SM, k8

r 14 – 15 – 16: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, SM, k12, SM, k8

r 17: k7 (11), p1, k2, c4b, c4b, k5, SM, M1R, k12, M1L, SM, k8

r 18 – 19 – 20: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, SM, k14, SM, k8

r 21: k7 (11), p1, c4f, c4f, c4f, k3, p1, SM, M1R, k14, M1L, SM, k8

r 22 – 23 – 24: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, SM, k16, SM, k8

r 25: k7 (11), p1, k2, c4b, c4b, k5, p1, remove M, k1, place the next 14 sts on waste yarn, cast on 2 sts, k1, remove M, k8

r 26 – 27 – 28: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, k12

r 29: k7 (11), p1, c4f, c4f, k7, p1, k12

r 30 – 31 – 32: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, k12

r 33: k7 (11), p1, k2, c4b, k9, p1, k12

r 34 – 35 – 36: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, k12

r 37: k7 (11), p1, c4f, k11, p1, k12

r 38 – 39 – 40: k7 (11), p1, k15, p1, k12

Switch to smaller needles and setup ribbing.

r 41 – 45: * k1, p1 * around

r 46: BO all sts in pattern



Left hand

r 1 – 4 : k13, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 5 : k13, p1, k11, c4b, p1, k8 (12)

r 6 (begin thumb gusset) : k7, PM, k6, PM, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 7 : k7, SM, M1L, k6, M1R, SM, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 8 : k7, SM, k8, SM, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 9 : k7, SM, M1L, k8, M1R, SM, p1, k9, c4f, k2, p1, k8 (12)

r 10 – 11 – 12 : k7, SM, k10, SM, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 13 : k7, SM, M1L, k10, M1R, SM, p1, k7, c4b, c4b, p1, k8 (12)

r 14 – 15 – 16 : k7, SM, k12, SM, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 17 : k7, SM, M1L, k12, M1R, SM, p1, k5, c4f, c4f, k2, p1, k8 (12)

r 18 – 19 – 20 : k7, SM, k14, SM, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 21 : k7, SM, M1L, k14, M1R, SM, p1, k3, c4b, c4b, c4b, p1, k8 (12)

r 22 – 23 – 24 : k7, SM, k16, SM, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 25 : k7, remove M, k1, place the next 14 sts on waste yarn, cast on 2 sts, k1, remove M, p1, k5, c4f, c4f, k2, p1, k8 (12)

r 26 – 27 – 28 : k11, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 29 : k11, p1, k7, c4b, c4b, p1, k8 (12)

r 30 – 31 – 32 : k11, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 33 : k11, p1, k9, c4f, k2, p1, k8 (12)

r 34 – 35 – 36 : k11, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

r 37 : k11, p1, k11, c4b, p1, k8 (12)

r 38 – 39 – 40 : k11, p1, k15, p1, k8 (12)

Switch to smaller needles and setup ribbing.

r 41 – 45 : * k1, p1 * around

r 46 : BO all sts in pattern

Thumb (make two)

Using bigger needles, place 14 held sts back on needles. Pick up 2 sts from the previous CO and join in the round. PM for BOR between these new sts. [16 sts]

r 1 – 5 : knit

Switch to smaller needles and setup ribbing

r 6 – 8 : * k1, p1 * around

r 9 : BO all sts in pattern
