



# THE FREE FRIDAY PATTERN

Flambé 3 BY BORGIO DE' PAZZI

*Roma Pizzoni*

Marea Shawl **INCONSUETO**  
*atelier*

*This project is beginner friendly and it's worked by flat rows.  
You must increase and decrease in every odd rows , working the even rows how you  
found it (knitting the knits, purling the purls).*

**SIZE:**

Before blocking you should have a triangle 210 cm long and 70 cm high

**MATERIAL:**

- YARN: 250gr FLAMBE' Borgo dè pazzi Firenze in your favourite color (I chose the n.57)

- 6mm x100 cm circular needles (or the right size to obtain the right gauge)
- scissors
- wool needle

**GAUGE:**

10x10 cm square: 23 stitches worked in stockinette for 22 rows

**STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS:**

ST: stitch

KFB: knit in front and back (increase)

K2TG: knit two stitches together (decrease)

K: knit

P: purl



## INSTRUCTIONS:

Cast on 9 stitches with your favourite method.

**Row 1:** 2K, 2P, 1K, 2P, 2K

**Row 2:** 2P, 2K, 1P, 2K, 2P

**Row 3:** 2K, 2P, 1KFB, 2P, 2K

**Row 4:** 2P, 2K, 1P in every ST until the last 4ST, 2K, 2P

**Row 5:** 2K, 2P, 1KFB, 1K in every ST until the last 4ST, 2P, 2K

Alternate row 4 and row 5 until you have 100 stitches on your needles.

At this point your shawl will have reached its maximum height.

Now you can start to decrease, but first, work row 4 one time (wrong side) to set your work on the right side again and start the decreasing rows.

Let's go:

**Row 1:** 2K, 2P, K2TOG, 1K in every ST until the last 4ST, 2P, 2K

**Row 2:** 2P, 2K, 1P in every ST until the last 4ST, 2K, 2P

Alternate row 1 and row 2 until you have again 9 stitches on your needles.

Cast off.

Ready!
